Criteria that can help you assess your community needs and potential benefits of tourism:

COST OF TOURISM	ASSESSMENT OF COMMUNITY'S ABILITY TO ABSORB COST
Tourism requires operational and capital cost.	Example: Our community has a \$200,000 budget for tourism development.

Tourism brings strangers into the community whose activities conflict with those of residents.	
Tourism brings outsiders into communities and may conflict with residents who do not accept cultural differences.	
Residents must exhibit tolerance of tourists who may be unfamiliar with the community and its lifestyle.	
Environmental	
Increased use of resources by tourists can degrade their quality and the communities overall environment.
